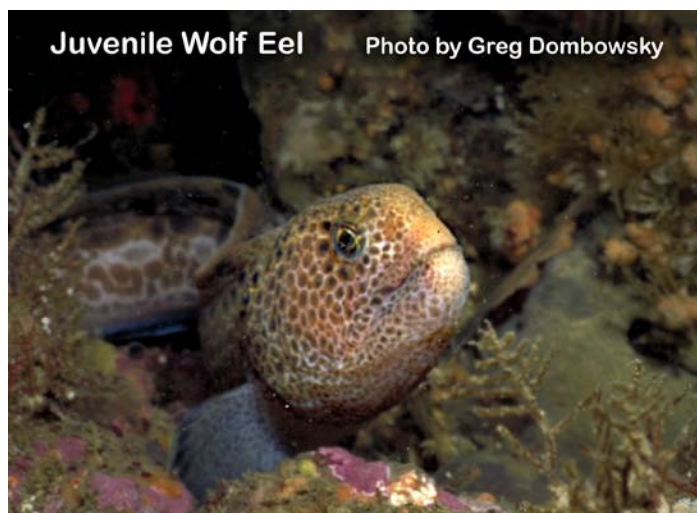

VICTORIA DIVING

Victoria is located on the southern tip of Vancouver Island. Vancouver Island is an international dive destination hosting the second best diving in the world, next only to the Red Sea with respect to rich, abundant sea life. During your stay in Victoria you will be at the doorstep of breath-taking, world class dive sites.

Victoria has over fifteen local shore dives each offering its own unique setting. This allows us to offer you a vast number of training sites. You may encounter a Giant Pacific Octopus, the largest species of octopus in the world, or you may have the opportunity to play with a wolf eel. There are countless species of sponge, anemones, sea stars, and other invertebrates, not to mention the many varieties of fish, making each dive new and exciting. Most dive sites are an average of 10-15 minutes away from Frank Whites Scuba Shop.

Along with our abundance of shore dives we also have an endless number of boat dives. Well-known Race Rocks is rated as one of the best dive sites on Vancouver Island. Here you will find the swift currents feed colorful invertebrates, such as soft corals, basket stars, and brooding anemones. Race Rocks also attracts hundreds of California & Steller Sea Lions each year. Diving with sea lions is an experience that is not soon forgotten, often referred to as ballet dancers of the sea, they will literally come within inches of you as they play and dance. Another famous site you will have the opportunity to dive is the H.M.C.S. Mackenzie. The H.M.C.S. Mackenzie is a 366 ft destroyer sunk as an artificial reef off the coast of Sidney in September, 1995. The H.M.C.S. McKenzie will be used as a training site during your wreck specialty course!



Along with having excellent dive sites, Victoria also has many above water activities for you to enjoy. For the outdoor enthusiasts, activities like wind surfing, kayaking, hiking, sailing, skiing, and golfing are year round.

Victoria is an exciting city offering a variety of beaches, shopping and nightlife, which are easily accessible by bus, bike or foot. Your stay in Victoria will make your course an experience to remember.

PADI PROFESSIONAL PLUS INSTRUCTOR COURSE

The PADI Professional Plus Instructor Course is a 12-14 week full time course providing training in Advanced, Emergency First Response, Rescue, and Divemaster levels. In addition to your Advanced to Dive Master certifications, you will broaden your knowledge of diving through a series of different specialty courses. You will also go through internships giving you experience with actual students and offering insights into effective ways to run scuba courses. Your program finishes with your Instructor Development Course (IDC). The IDC is an intensive program where you will learn comprehensive teaching techniques that you will use when you teach your own courses. Completion of the IDC will mean that you are familiar with the PADI system of diver training, you will know how to conduct academic, confined water and open water sessions and you meet the prerequisite training for the Instructors Examination (IE). The IE is independently conducted by PADI Canada and is a two day evaluation on the same criteria that you learned in the IDC Your final training will be conducted at the Instructor level where you receive instruction for your PADI Emergency First Response Instructor, DAN 02 Instructor, and five Specialty Instructor level certifications. Completion of the I.E will complete your training and certify you as a PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor and on your way towards your PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainer rating.

PADI PROFESSIONAL INSTRUCTOR COURSE

The PADI Professional Instructor Course curriculum is run on the same 12-14 week full time schedule as the PADI Professional Plus Instructor Course. This means that PADI Professional Instructor Course students are provided with the same training and dive industry workshops as the Pro Plus students. As in the PADI Professional Plus Instructor Course, the beginning of the course will be spent providing training in Advanced, Emergency First Response, Rescue, and Divemaster levels. In addition to your Advanced to Dive Master certifications, you will broaden your knowledge of diving through a series of different specialty diver courses. You will also go through internships giving you experience with actual students and offering insights into effective ways to run scuba courses. Your program finishes with your Instructor Development Course (IDC). The IDC is an intensive program where you will learn comprehensive teaching techniques that you will use when you teach your own courses. Admission Policy

- 1) Registration Fee of \$100.00 is due at time of application.
- 2) Course deposit of \$500.00 due 30 days prior to course start date.
- 3) Completed medical signed by a physician.
- 4) Front and back copies of your open water certification.
- 5) Log book
- 6) 22 passport size photographs for the PADI Professional Plus Instructor Course or 18 photos for the PADI Professional Instructor Course.
- 7) 18 years or older and have a high school diploma, or
- 8) Mature student status - 19 years old and not attended school for at least 52 weeks.
- 9) Must be certified as a PADI Open Water diver or equivalent for three months or longer.
(Must have at least 60 logged dives upon completion of course)

Instructor Examination

The I.E. is run independently by PADI Head Office. Therefore there is an additional fee paid directly to PADI by the student. The following prerequisites must be met prior to attending the I.E.

- 1) Must have completed a PADI Instructor Development course.
- 2) Must be certified as a PADI Open Water diver or equivalent for at least one year
- 3) Must have at least 100 logged dives

Dismissal Policy

- Absenteeism for longer than two (2) consecutive days without informing the school and provision of a doctor's note may result in dismissal. Students on student loans: Any student who is not in attendance for a maximum time limit of six (6) days in a two week period must be withdrawn from their course of study.
- Cheating or plagiarism
- Physical abuse of institution's property
- Theft or non-accidental damage to the institution's property
- Behavior displaying insubordination, refusal to cooperate with instructors and schedules
- The use of alcohol or nonprescription drugs is prohibited while in attendance at the institution
